SCHOOL UPDATES

Thank you to everyone who has applied for their family ID cards. The distribution process has started for students in Grades 5 to 12; please remind your child/ren to give them to you. If you haven't applied for a family ID card, you may still do so by completing the google form sent to your email on December 23rd.

As mentioned in last week's communication, we are currently studying the feasibility of offering a bus service to the ABA community. Please complete **this form** if you are interested in your child/ren using a bus service provided by the school. Moving forward, students and their parents will only be able to purchase/ top up the prepaid cards on Mondays in the Admin building from 7 to 9 am. Students can also purchase top/up their cards on Mondays in the cafeteria from 9 am to 3 pm (excluding break times).



From next week, the vendor will no longer accept cash as payment for food items/ beverages. The minimum amount to purchase a prepaid card is 10.500 (inclusive of vat). Minimum top up is five rials, however, please top up according to your needs whilst remembering that you can only top up on a Monday.




